Post Conference Session: Connecting the Dots on Affordable Housing

Description:

Access to affordable housing is a crucial issue across B.C. No one level of government can solve this alone, so we're working together. Municipal Affairs and Housing staff will present an overview of the 30-point housing plan in Budget 2018 and share information on the HousingHub – a new office at BC Housing that will partner with all levels of government, developer, community and Indigenous partners to actively create more affordable housing.

They will share some of the key ideas from the successful Housing Partnerships Conference last December and the government's response to the UBCM Housing Strategy report. The facilitators will present and ask for feedback on an innovative proposal for the province and local governments to meet housing goals together through a partnership agreement. UBCM Members will have an important opportunity to ask questions, shape the partnership agreement concept and share ideas at this session.
